Pakistan's terrorism monitoring authority "NACTA" added the Sindhudesh Revolutionary Army (SRA) into its Proscribed organizations list on 07 May, 2020. This militant organization also joined hands with baloch sub-national terrorist organizations including BLA, BLF to target Pakistani military.

Formed: December 2010

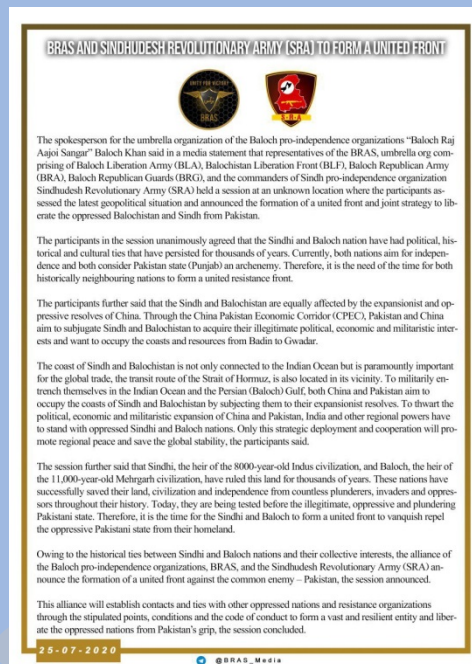
First Attack: 2010

## Alliance:

On 26 July 2020, SRI came in an alliance with BRAS (Baloch Raji Ajoi Sangar (BRAS)). BRAS is a coalition of 4 Baloch subnational militant organizations including Balochistan Liberation Front (BLF), Baloch Republican Guards (BRG), Baloch Liberation Army (BRA) and Baloch Republican Army (BRA).

## Activities:

Sindhuhadesh Revolutionary Army (SRA) targets railways lines and trains, electricity transmission lines, telecommunication towers and Pakistani forces in province Sindh.

To accomplish its goal of establishing an independent Sindhi state, the SRA employs IEDs, landmines, grenades, small-arms attacks, conventional warfare, unconventional warfare, social media, and nationalist propaganda.

## **Major Attacks:**

1. IED attack against a Pakistan Coast Guard vehicle in Karachi, (1 killed, 10 injured) (12 May, 2022)
2. IED attack against a pro-Kashmir rally in Karachi, (0 killed, 39 injured) (5 Aug, 2020)
3. IED attacks against Pakistani paramilitary forces, (4 killed, 8 injured) (19 June, 2020)
